

ISTHE BIBLE REALLY THE WORD OF GOD?





Matthew 7:13-14 "Go in through the narrow gate, because the gate to hell is wide and the road that leads to it is easy, and there are many who travel

it. But the gate to life is narrow and the way that leads to it is hard, and there are few people who find it."

John 14:6 "Jesus told him, "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one can come to the Father except through me."

1. What does the Bible say about being God's Word?

A. The Bible claims to be God's direct revelation of His values, principles and expectations.

2 Timothy 3:16 "All Scripture is inspired by God and is useful to teach us what is true and to make us realize what is wrong in our

lives. It corrects us when we are wrong and teaches us to do what is right."

B. The Bible was written by people who were specifically directed by God in what to say.

2 Peter 1:20-21 "Above all, you must realize that no prophecy in Scripture ever came from the prophet's own understanding, or from

human initiative. No, those prophets were moved by the Holy Spirit, and they spoke from God."

C. Because these are the words of God who is always truthful and accurate, the content represents truth for humankind.

John 8:26 "I have much to say about you and much to condemn, but I won't. For I say only

what I have heard from the one who sent me, and he is completely truthful."

D. Because they present God's words to us, the Scriptures are authoritative.

Romans 1:2 "God promised this Good News long ago through his prophets in the holy Scriptures."

2. There are other facts that show the credibility of the Bible as the Word of God.

A. Ever since it was written there have been various Jewish and Christian faith communities that have upheld the claim that it came from God.

B. People have endured untold persecution to the point of death because they believed this was the Word of God.

C. Although there have been many critics of the Bible, the Bible still stands today while they have gone away.

1 Peter 1:24-25 "As the scripture says, 'All human beings are like grass, and all their glory is like wild flowers. The grass withers,

and the flowers fall, but the Word of the Lord remains forever."

D. The Bible is consistent even though it was written by at least 40 authors from 13 different countries on three continents over a period of 1600 years.

E. The Bible is more documented than any other writing-ever!

Having said all this, these are still not irrefutable proofs.


However, there is one irrefutable proof that proves the Bible is the authoritative Word of God.

3. If these things are true, then what should we do about it?

He also gave us the Bible so we could have access to His thoughts and principles for life to help us make the <u>right decisions</u> in life.

C. Rely on the Holy Spirit to illuminate the Scriptures' meaning for your particular life situation.

D. Base every decision in our life on what the Bible says to do. E. Speak the truth in love.
